

ORDINANCE #1

CONSTABLE

Adopted April 3, 1978

Effective Immediately.

An Ordinance to limit the number of constables to one; pursuant to Sections 358 and 362 of Act No. 116 of the Public Acts of 1954, section 362 as amended by Act No. 103 of the Public Acts of 1973, being Sections 168.358 and 168.362 of the Capital Laws of 1970.

The Township of Summit, Mason County, Michigan
Hereby Ordains:

Section I.

The number of constables to be elected shall be determined by the Township Board not less than six months before the Township election.

Section II.

There shall be no more than one constable elected at any time.

Section III.

This ordinance shall take immediate effect. All ordinances or part of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
