

## Special Meeting

July 13, 2015

A special meeting of the Summit Township Board was called to order at 5:32 pm by Supervisor Wayne Kelly

Members present: Supervisor Kelly, Mary Samuels Clerk, Mary Bedker Treasurer, Trustees Terry Woirol and Duane Cooper.  
All members were present.

The purpose of this meeting was to discuss a proposed change in the road project for Brye Road from a seal coat surface to a HMA surface.

After much discussion a motion was made by Cooper seconded by Bedker to continue with the original contract from Anthony Road South to new HMA surface from 2014, for a seal coat surface in the amount of \$12,500.00 Ayes all. Motion carried.

Information was received from the Mason County Road Commission regarding an abandonment request from Reginald Yaple for the following area:

The portion of Lennox Street, an undeveloped/ paper street, Summit Township, requested for partial abandonment between Ave A and Ave B, in the Plat of Bass Lake Park. More specifically, it is the section of road located between lots 2 -14, Block 11, Plat of Bass Lake Park, and lots 27 -39, Block 10, Plat of Bass Lake Park, Section 35 of T-17-N, R-18-W, Summit Twp, Mason County. The Petitioner, Mr. Reginald Yaple, owns on both sides of this portion of Lennox Street. The portion of Pine Avenue, an undeveloped/ paper street, Summit Township, requested for partial abandonment between Ave A and Ave B, in the Plat of Bass Lake Park. More specifically, it is the section of road located between lots 5 -15, Block 20, Plat of Bass Lake Park, and lots 26 -36, Block 11, Plat of Bass Lake Park, Section 35 of T-17-N, R-18-W, Summit Twp, Mason County. The Petitioner, Mr. Reginald Yaple, owns on both sides of this portion of Pine Avenue. The portion of Michigan Avenue, an undeveloped/ paper street, Summit Township, requested for partial abandonment between Ave B and Ave C, in the Plat of Bass Lake Park. More specifically, it is the section of road located between lots 29 -40, Block 19, Plat of Bass Lake Park, and lots 1 -9, Block 3, Plat of Nagasaki Park, Section 35 of T-17-N, R-18-W, Summit Twp, Mason County. The Petitioner, Mr. Reginald Yaple, owns on both sides of this portion of Michigan Ave. After much discussion a motion was made by Samuels seconded by Woirol to approve the abandonment request by Mr. Yaple. Ayes all. Motion carried.

An abandonment request was also received from Mr. Phil Arnold for a platted road (Avenue A) to be abandoned that adjoins lots 54 through 62 of block 16 in Nagasaki Park. This platted avenue is located 100% in the critical dune area and is on an extreme slope exceeding 80% making it unbuildable. This action does not cut off any property owner's access. After much discussion a motion was made by Bedker and seconded by Cooper to approve Mr. Arnolds request to abandon this platted road. Ayes all. Motion carried.
