

**ORDINANCE ADDRESSING FLOODPLAIN MANAGEMENT PROVISIONS  
OF THE STATE CONSTRUCTION CODE**

Community Name: Township of Summit, County: Mason

**Ordinance number 14.1**

An Ordinance Amendment to Affirm an enforcing agency to discharge the responsibility of the Township of Summit located in Mason County, and to designate regulated flood hazard areas under the provisions of the State Construction Code Act, Act No. 230 of the Public Acts of 1972, as amended.

The Township of Summit ordains:

**Section 1. AGENCY DESIGNATED.** Pursuant to the provisions of the state construction code, in accordance with Section 8b(6) of Act 230, of the Public Acts of 1972, as amended, the Building Inspector of the County of Mason is hereby designated as the enforcing agency to discharge the responsibility of the Township of Summitt under Act 230, of the Public Acts of 1972, as amended, State of Michigan. The County of Mason assumes responsibility for the administration and enforcement of said Act through out the corporate limits of the community adopting this ordinance.

**Section 2. CODE APPENDIX ENFORCED.** Pursuant to the provisions of the state construction code, in accordance with Section 8b(6) of Act 230, of the Public Acts of 1972, as amended, Appendix G of the Michigan Building Code shall be enforced by the enforcing agency within the jurisdiction of the community adopting this ordinance.

**Section 3. DESIGNATION OF REGULATED FLOOD PRONE HAZARD AREAS.** The Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) Flood Insurance Study (FIS) Entitled "Flood Insurance Study, Mason County 26105C0333C" and dated August 24, 2021 and the Flood Insurance Rate Map(s) (FIRMS) panel number(s) of 26105CIND0B, 26105C0239D, 26105C0245D, 26105C0327D, 26105C0331D, 26105C0333D and 26105C0335D dated August

24, 2021 are adopted by reference for the purposes of administration of the Michigan Construction Code, and declared to be a part of Section 1612.3 of the Michigan Building Code, and to provide the content of the "Flood Hazards" section of Table R301.2(1) of the Michigan Residential Code.

**Section 4. REPEALS.** All ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

**Section 5. PUBLICATION.** This ordinance shall be effective after legal publication and in accordance with the provisions of the Act governing same.

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
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
