Commission Members absent: Treasurer, Mary Bedker and Supervisor, Wayne Kelly



The meeting was called to order at 9:00 a.m. by Pere Marquette Charter Township Clerk Embody.

NEW BUSINESS: A. Conduct the Public Accuracy Test for the February 27, 2024 Presidential Primary Election

The official Public Accuracy Test began at 9:00 a.m. The Summit Township Election Commission member and the Summit Deputy Clerk confirmed that the tabulator for the Presidential Primary election held at the township hall was at zero and the Zero Totals Reports confirmed there were no votes previously recorded by the tabulators. The test deck and predetermined chart of results were prepared in accordance with the requirements established by Michigan Election law and the Electronic Voting Systems Promulgated Rules. After all the test ballots were tabulated, the results reports were printed, reviewed by the Summit Election Commission/Clerk Deanda and Deputy Clerk Samuels, County Clerk Kelly and Deputy Clerk Holmes and confirmed with the pre-determined chart of results. The test results were cleared from the equipment, resetting all totals to zero, and the program seal numbers were recorded on the Tabulator Program Testing and Security Certification. Upon completion of the test and count, the zeros tapes, test decks, programs, predetermined chart of results, test materials, test ballots arranged by precincts, and results of the Public Accuracy Test were secured and sealed in an approved test ballot container.
