Supervisor Kelly called the Summit Election Commission meeting to order at 5:45 pm.

Members Present: Supervisor Wayne Kelly, Clerk Kay Deanda, Treasurer Mary Bedker.

At this meeting of the Summit Election Commission held on the day of February 20, 2024, the following resolution was adopted:

Resolution #2024-01
Consolidation of Precincts For May 7, 2024 Special Election

Whereas, the State of Michigan has adopted legislation to consolidate elections; and,

Whereas, this legislation includes provisions regarding school election administration; and,

Whereas, Mason County City and Township Clerks and Local School Administrators have monitored the conduct of elections since Election Consolidation on January 1, 2005, including “mixed elections” (election day consisting of both school issues and municipal issues on the same ballot), and have determined that the voters in Mason County would be best served by the majority of voters going to their municipal polling locations for all elections.

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved, the Summit Election Commission authorizes the Combination of Summit and Pentwater Township into one Precinct to be named Pentwater Township for the May 7, 2024 Special Election under *MCL 168.659 Consolidation of election precincts- Voters not going to their normal municipal precinct, (fractional voters), will be sent notices indicating what polling location to vote at*

Voting location is at the Pentwater Township Hall: 500 N. Hancock St., Pentwater, MI 49449

Per the Qualified Voter File this only affects four voters in Summit Township, at this time aside from same day voters.

Motion by Kelly seconded by Bedker to adopt the foregoing resolution. Motion carried.

The meeting was adjourned at 5:55 pm.
